PRECAUTIONS: POTENTIAL SKIN SENSITIZER. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. HARMFUL OR FATAL IF SWALLOWED OR ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN. CAUSES EYE DAMAGE AND SKIN IRRITATIONS. Do not get into eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing vapor or mist. Use with adequate ventilation. Wear a full-face NIOSH-approved respirator, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt, and shoes plus socks and a chemical-resistant apron during mixing/loading, clean up, and repair activities. Discard clothing or other absorbent materials that have been drenched or heavily contaminated with this product's concentrate. Do not re-use them. Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Users should remove clothing/protective equipment immediately if this product comes in contact with the skin through soaked clothing or spills. Then wash skin thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Wash contaminated clothing separate from other laundry before re-use.

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
