#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

**PRECAUTIONS:** PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Causes eye irritation. DO NOT get in eyes. Potential skin sensitizer. Wear protective clothing including suitable chemical resistant gloves, mask and goggles when handling this product. Avoid breathing dust. Use in well-ventilated area. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling product and before eating, drinking or smoking. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and water before reuse. This product is toxic to fish. #### **FIRST AID:**

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

### **TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:**

Tetrachlorvinphos is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Typical symptoms of overexposure to cholinesterase inhibitors include headache, nausea, dizziness, sweating, salivation, runny nose and eyes. This may progress to muscle twitching, weakness, tremor, incoordination, vomiting, abdominal cramps and diarrhea in more serious poisonings. A life-threatening poisoning is signified by loss of consciousness, incontinence, convulsions and respiratory depression with a secondary cardiovascular component. Treat symptomatically. If exposed, plasma and red blood cell cholinesterase tests may indicate degree of exposure (baseline data are useful). Atropine, only by injection, is the preferable antidote. Oximes, such as Pralidoxime Chloride, may be therapeutic if used early; however, use only in conjunction with atropine. In cases of severe acute poisoning, use antidotes immediately after establishing an open airway and respiration. With oral exposure, the decision of whether to induce vomiting or not should be made by an attending physician.

#### **STORAGE:**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by the storage or disposal of this product. Store in the original, tightly sealed container. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place away from food, feed, seed, fertilizer, or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame, or other sources of heat.

# **DECONTAMINATION AND DISPOSAL:**

Canadian formulators using this product should dispose of unwanted active ingredient and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and cleanup of spills, contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.
