DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For mildew prevention, use ENDEW as directed.

For 2 week protection, add 32 ml per 100 kg of fabric (dry weight)

For 3 week protection, add 120 ml per 100 kg of fabric (dry weight)

For 4 week protection, add 140 ml per 100 kg of fabric (dry weight)

For bacterial control, use ENDEW as directed.

At 65 ml per 100 kg of fabric (dry weight), ENDEW imparts a residual self-sanitizing finish and residual bacteriostatic finish to the fabric.

At 140 ml per 100 kg of fabric (dry weight), ENDEW sanitizes and imparts a residual self-sanitizing and residual bacteriostatic finish to the fabric.

Dilute the appropriate amount of ENDEW in four to eight litres of water, then add to the wash in the final rinse, after souring. Water temperature should be at or above 25°C and the contact time should be at least 10 minutes. Treat fabrics as often and whenever conditions indicate it is necessary.

This product should not be used or compounded with any reducing or oxidizing agents (such as calcium hypochlorite, solid perchlorate or nitric acid) since such mixtures may be explosive. Do not use in conjunction with soap or any anionic wetting agent. Under certain conditions, the use of protective creams may be advisable. Wash thoroughly after handling.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Fatal if swallowed. Corrosive to eyes and skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Avoid contamination of food. When handling this concentrate wear goggles or a face shield, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long-sleeved shirt, and shoes plus socks. Wear dust mist respirator if mist is generated.

FIRST-AID

IF ON SKIN/CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed. Treat symptomatically.
