DIRECTIONS FOR INDOOR USE: Remove pets, birds and fish bowls. Open cabinets and doors in the area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one can for each 300 cubic metres of unobstructed area.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Can be used manually or valve can be locked in open position. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, depress valve lever down firmly until it clicks and stays depressed. For best results, first spray distant rooms manually, spraying towards ceiling, 4 to 6 seconds is ample for an average (3m x 3m x 3m) room. Also spray into cracks and crevices. Place can on stand or table in centre of 300 cubic metres of unobstructed area, then lock valve open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for 2 hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and ventilate for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in 2 weeks if necessary. This formulation will kill exposed insects only and has no residual control activity.

CAUTION: Do not use in dwellings or in food storage handling, or service establishment as a total release bomb with valve locked open.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Exposure to prolonged sunlight or other sources of heat may cause bursting. Do not throw into fire or incinerator or store at temperatures above 50°C. Do not spray on walls, composition tile or plastic. Do not spray over exposed food. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not spray into or near any open flame.

FIRST AID: If onkin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT RECOMMENDATIONS: For resistance management, please note that Doktor Doom Fumigator Total Release contains a Group 3 insecticide. Any insect population may contain individuals naturally resistant to Doktor Doom Fumigator Total Release and other Group 3 insecticides. The resistant individuals may dominate the insect population if this group of insecticides are used repeatedly in the same fields. Other resistance mechanisms that are not linked to site of action but are specific for individual chemicals, such as enhanced metabolism, may also exist. Appropriate resistance-management strategies should be followed. To delay insecticide resistance:

- Where possible, rotate the use of Doktor Doom Fumigator Total Release or other Group 3 insecticides with different groups that control the same pests in a field.
- Use tank mixtures with insecticides from a different group when such use is permitted.
- Insecticide/acaricide use should be based on an IPM program that includes scouting, record keeping, and considers cultural, biological and other chemical control practices.
- Monitor treated pest populations for resistance development.
- Contact your local extension specialist or certified crop advisors for any additional pesticide resistance-management and/or IPM recommendations for the specific site and pest problems in your area.
