DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of antimicrobial products registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*. Manufacturers are responsible for their own registrations.

**PRECAUTIONS:**

**PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.**

**WARNING CORROSIVE:** Avoid contact with skin and eyes. May cause severe skin and eye irritation or chemical burns to broken skin. Causes eye damage. Wear safety glasses or goggles and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash after handling. Avoid breathing vapors. Vacate poorly ventilated areas as soon as possible. Do not return until odors have dissipated. Harmful if swallowed.

Mix only with water according to directions. Do not mix with any other chemical. Dangerous gas forms when mixed with acid.

**FIRST AID:**

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGY INFORMATION:**

Treat symptomatically.

**STORAGE:**

Store in a cool dry area, away from direct sunlight and heat to avoid deterioration.

**DECONTAMINATION AND DISPOSAL:**

In case of spill, flood areas with large quantities of water. Product or rinsates that cannot be used should be diluted with water before disposal in a sanitary sewer.
