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## **WOOD AND WOOD PRODUCTS**

This product tank mixed with CCA is recommended for the protection of wood and wood products. Refer to the CCA product label for specific acceptable uses.

Treat with 7.5 ppm - 12 ppm of this product (7.5 ml - 12 ml per 1000 litres, or 9.4 gm - 15 gm per 1000 litres) in CCA dilute solution in the pressure treating process for mold and mildew control. Under extreme mold and mildew conditions the addition of this product may be used up to a maximum concentration of 30 ppm (30 ml per 1000 litres or 37.5 gm per 1000 litres).

Thoroughly wet and allow to dry. This application will afford protection for 12 weeks.

This product weighs 1.25 kg per litre (12.5 lbs per imperial gallon).

For further information on storage, handling, use, and disposal of treated wood, contact the manufacturer of this product or the provincial regulatory agency.

Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not swallow. Avoid breathing vapours and spray mists. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. It is not to be used in circumstances that would cause or allow it to enter lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters in contravention of federal or provincial regulatory requirements. The requirements of applicable laws should be determined before using the product. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Store treated lumber on a roofed drip pad until dripping has ceased. Slope lumber on the drip pad to expedite drainage and to ensure that no puddles remain on the surface of the wood. Contain drippage and other related wastes to prevent release in the environment.

DO NOT expose treated lumber to heavy rains immediately after treatment. DO NOT float treated lumber in lakes, rivers, streams or oceans.

## **STORAGE**

This product as supplied evolves gas (largely carbon dioxide) slowly. To prevent buildup of pressure the product is packaged in specially vented containers. Keep this product in the original container when not in use. Container must be stored and transported in an upright position to prevent spilling the contents through the vent. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

## **FIRST AID**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
