INTERNAL

FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

VINYL COMPOUNDS

A level of 1% of this product based on total weight of plastisol will give excellent control against bacteria and mold organisms. This level is recommended for shower curtains, wall coverings and similar items. For example, in a 1000 kg batch requiring 1.0% of this product per total weight, 10 kg of the plasticizer or polyol would be replaced with 10 kg of this product. It is important to remember that the cost of using this product is, therefore, calculated as the difference in cost between this product and the replaced plasticizer. This product should be added early in the blending operation to assure homogeneity. It is recommended that microbiological, chemical and physical testing be done to determine the optimum level of biological agent required for each compound. Rohm and Haas Chemicals LLC has such facilities to assist manufacturers in determining the optimum level.
