DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture, formulation or repackaging of products which are registered under the Pest Control Products Act.

PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

May be irritating to the lungs and respiratory tract. Avoid inhalation of dusts or particles of this product.

Wear a face mask suitable for fine dust during handling. Wear chemical resistant gloves and footwear, and chemical resistant clothing with head covering at all times during handling.

Handle with care

Use only in well ventilated areas.

When handling, do not eat, drink or smoke.

Take a shower immediately after work. Wear freshly laundered clothes daily.

Wash hands and face before eating, drinking, smoking and using the toilet.

Store and wash all protective clothing separately from household laundry.

Wash protective clothing in detergent and hot water before reuse.

FIRST AID

If swallowed:

Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing:

Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled:

Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes:

Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

May cause irritancy.

Copper dust may cause symptoms similar to the common cold with chills and stuffiness of the head. Long term overexposure may cause skin irritation or discolouration of the skin and hair. Ingestion may cause irritation, nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, haemorrhagic gastritis and diarrhea. Prolonged absorption of thiocyanate may cause skin eruptions, dizziness, nausea, vomiting and nervous system disorders.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Toxic to aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water. Do not apply directly to water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Contact with acids or oxidizing agents liberates toxic gases.
