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## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

To be used only in the manufacture of a product which is registered under the **Pest Control Products Act**. Read Technical Bulletin for formulation details.

## **PRECAUTIONS FOR USE**

### **PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.**

### **CORROSIVE to the eyes. DO NOT get in the eyes.**

**WARNING!** Causes skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, and clothing. Avoid breathing vapour or mist. Use with adequate ventilation. Wash thoroughly after handling.

Wear goggles or eye shield to protect eyes when handling **Agnique FOH 8-10SP**. Wear gloves and protective clothing when handling **Agnique FOH 8-10SP** to minimize skin contact. Where mist or vapours are generated, respiratory protection is recommended.

## **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

*Storage:* Store **Agnique FOH 8-10SP** in a cool dry place.

*Disposal:* Canadian formulators using this product should dispose of unwanted active and containers in accordance with municipal and provincial regulations. For additional details and clean-up of spills contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.

## **FIRST AID**

*Contact with eyes:* Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

*Contact with skin or clothing:* Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

*Inhalation:* Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

*Ingestion:* Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
