### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

To be used only in the manufacture of a rodenticide which is registered under the Pest Control Product Act. Consult technical bulletin for manufacturing procedures.

### **PRECAUTIONS**

**KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.**

May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. May cause eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Do not breathe vapor spray mist. In the case of cleanup following a spill, wear protective clothing and appropriate equipment to prevent exposure of skin and eyes and to prevent ingestion or inhalations.

### **FIRST AID:**

**IN CASE OF INGESTION: CONTACT A POISON CONTROL CENTRE IMMEDIATELY OR CONTACT A PHYSICIAN.**

If swallowed, drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or if available, by administering one or two teaspoons of syrup of ipecac. This should be followed by administering activated charcoal, milk, beaten eggs or suspension of flour or starch. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If convulsions are not present, gastric lavage could be done.

**IN CASE OF INHALATION CONTACT:**

Remove victim to fresh air. If breathing difficulty occurs get medical attention. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth resuscitation, and get medical attention immediately.

**IN THE CASE OF SKIN CONTACT:**

Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

**IN CASE OF EYE CONTACT:**

Flush eyes with plenty of water and call an ophthalmologist or a physician.
