**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide which is registered under the *PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT*.

**PRECAUTIONS:**

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND/OR PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED. CAUSES IRRITATION TO EYES AND SKIN. AVOID CONTACT WITH SKIN, EYES, OR CLOTHING. AVOID INHALING DUST. DO NOT USE SO AS TO CONTAMINATE WATER INTENDED FOR IRRIGATION OR DOMESTIC PURPOSES. DO NOT CONTAMINATE LAKES, STREAMS OR PONDS. ### **FIRST AID:**

**EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**INHALATION:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

**INGESTION:** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

### **TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:**

Classified by the World Health Organization as MODERATELY HAZARDOUS.

This product may cause severe irritation to the eyes. Overexposure to 2,4-D may cause coughing, burning, dizziness or temporary loss of muscle coordination. Other possible effects of overexposure include fatigue, muscle weakness or nausea.

Treat symptomatically.

### **DISPOSAL:**

Canadian formulators using this product should dispose of unwanted active ingredient and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and information on cleanup of spills, contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.

### **STORAGE:**

Always store pesticides in a cool, dry, secured warehouse or storage building. Do not store near seed, feed, fertilizers, insecticides or fungicides. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Keep away from fire or open flame, or other source of heat.
