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## **PRECAUTIONS**

Irritating to skin upon repeated and prolonged contact. Moderately irritating to eyes.

## **PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT**

Wear protective clothing (long trousers, long-sleeved shirts), impervious gloves and splash goggles during all mixing and loading. Protective clothing should be washed before re-use.

## **FIRST AID**

**If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.
