**DIRECTIONS:** Add 63 mL concentrate to 1 Litre of water and place in a non-metal container. To use place diluted Sterisol Germicide in a covered dish to a depth of about 4 cm. To sanitize, immerse mouthpieces, reed holders and pre-band instruments for one minute. Rinse with tap water before using. Make a fresh solution for each use, or when visibly soiled or contaminated.

**NOTE:** If equipment is dirty, wash before immersing in product. Articles washed with soap should be thoroughly rinsed before sanitizing with Sterisol Germicide.  
STERISOL GERMICIDE WILL NOT DAMAGE MATERIALS OR FINISH.

**PRECAUTIONS:** Avoid contamination of food. Wear rubber gloves when handling this concentrate.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

**FIRST AID:** If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 - 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 - 20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If swallowed call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**DISPOSAL:**

Do not reuse empty container.

Wrap empty container and discard in household garbage.
