**DORMANT SEASON:** Kills over-wintering red mites, leafrollers, pear psylla, scales and currant aphids. May be applied to all fruit trees, ornamental trees and shrubs except plants listed below. **Rate:** Mix 60 ml (4 tbsp) in 3 L of water and mix thoroughly. Shake frequently while using. DO NOT apply to any body of water. DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Avoid application of this product when winds are gusty.

**COMBINATION DORMANT SPRAY:** Fruit trees, roses and deciduous ornamentals. For over wintering insects, eggs, oystershell scales, San Jose scales, rose scales, black scales as well as over wintering fungus disease. **Rate:** Mix 120 ml (8 tbsp) of Green Earth<sup>®</sup> by Wilson<sup>®</sup> Lime Sulphur Concentrate and 60 ml (4 tbsp) of Green Earth<sup>®</sup> by Wilson<sup>®</sup> Horticultural Oil Insect Spray in 3 L of water. Apply in early spring when danger of frost is past, before leaf buds show green at tips. Spray on a mild morning to allow mixture to dry quickly. Do not spray during freezing weather. WARNING: May cause bark damage on Red Delicious, Empire and Mutsu apple trees.

**GROWING SEASON: Woody ornamentals:** To control scale insects, spider mites, whiteflies, mealybugs. **Rate:** Mix 10 ml (2 tsp) in 1 L of water and apply as a forceful spray, wetting pests and all parts of plants thoroughly.

**NOTE:** For plant safety, do not use on beech, butternut, Colorado blue spruce, Douglas fir, hickory, holly, sugar maple, Japanese maple and walnut. If in doubt about use on sensitive plants, test on a leaf or two. Spray damage will be apparent in 24 hours, if any.

**PRECAUTIONS:** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of spray mist.
