PRO® Magic Mist DS Insecticide is engineered for highly effective use in the PRO® Magic Mist Automatic Aerosol Dispensers or other similar type dispensers. The PRO® Magic Mist dispenser automatically releases a metered dose of 50-55 mg of insecticide every 15 minutes, killing flies, mosquitoes, gnats and certain other flying insects. PRO® Magic Mist DS Insecticide is designed for use in hospitals, restaurants, food processing plants, food service establishments, stables, barns and poultry houses while they are in operation. Also for use in meat processing and meat packaging plants, when not in operation. Each can contains enough product to protect an area of at least 170 m³ of free flow air space for up to 30 days.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Remove protective cap from top of can and insert can into PRO® Magic Mist dispenser. Place dispenser 2-3 metres above floor at a point where air flow will carry insecticide throughout the area. Do not install directly over food or feed packaging surfaces.

Stables, barns, poultry houses: Hang in any area where flying insects present a problem. Helps eliminate the need for washing down animals with insecticides. Keeps livestock and other farm animals protected.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. IN HOSPITALS do not use in nurseries or rooms where infants, ill or aged persons are confined. IN MEAT PACKAGING PLANTS, spray only when plant is not in operation. No exposed meat products, ingredients or packaging materials may be left in the room. Cover food handling equipment. Any treated surface that may contact meat products should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before reuse for meat processing. Contents under pressure. Container may explode if heated. Do not expose to temperatures over 50° C. Do not puncture or incinerate. Do not use in the presence of open flame or spark. Avoid contact with skin and inhalation of spray mist. Wash after using. Contents toxic to fish and birds. Do not contaminate food, feed or water. Do not install directly over polished, plastic or varnished surfaces.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of empty container with regular garbage.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If on skin or clothing,** take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. **If swallowed,** call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
