DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Disparvirus Technical is to be used only for the manufacture of an end-use product registered under the *Pest Control Products Act* for management of spongy moth populations.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, protective eyewear (goggles), waterproof gloves, socks and shoes and a NIOSH-approved particulate filtering facepiece respirator with any R or P filter when handling.

Do not contaminate any body of water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin/clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

General: Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

STORAGE:

Store product in original container at 4°C or less. Use within 6 months from the date of manufacture.

DISPOSAL:

Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal and provincial/territorial regulations. For additional details and clean up of spills, contact the manufacturer and the provincial/territorial regulatory agency.
