DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For outdoor use only.

Plantskydd Deer Repellent Pre-mixed RTU Solution prevents browsing damage by deer and elk on conifers for 2 to 4 months. May also repel deer and elk from browsing on dormant deciduous woody ornamentals. Plantskydd Deer Repellent Pre-mixed RTU Solution may also repel rabbits and hares from browsing on conifers and dormant deciduous woody ornamentals.

It is advisable to treat a small portion of plant(s) to determine sensitivity Plants treated with Plantskydd Deer Repellent Pre-mixed RTU Solution may experience some effects such as becoming darker in appearance. Original color returns after 1 or 2 days.

Avoid spraying surface of other substrates such as concrete and wood to prevent damage (e.g., discolouration).

- Shake well before each use.
- Apply above 0° C. For best results, apply in early morning or late afternoon.
- · Adjust nozzle for fine spray.
- Plants should be well hydrated prior to treatment.
- Spray on dry plants only. After rainfall or watering, wait until plants are dry.
- Apply to the parts of the plant which are frequently browsed.
- For deer and elk, spray mainly the top of plants.
- For rabbits and hares, spray mainly lower areas of the plant such as the stem.
- Expect some reduction in repellency during very warm and sunny weather (e.g., June-August).
- After spraying, allow to dry 1-2 days before watering.
- If sprayer clogs, flush with hot water.
- Close sprayer nozzle and rinse nozzle and gloves after use.

DO NOT apply to any body of water.

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

<u>Conifer seedlings:</u> For use on cedar, fir, pine, spruce and other conifer seedlings. Apply in late fall (overwinter browse) or early spring. Treat pine before or after, but not during, bud-flush period. Squeeze trigger twice for each dry plant. Do not increase the above dosage of two spray blasts per seedling! Seedlings should be wet but not dripping. Always treat new growth. Spray once or twice per year as browsing conditions warrant.

Established conifers and Dormant deciduous woody ornamentals: Apply in late fall (overwinter browse) or early spring. Treat pine before or after, but not during, bud-flush period. Spray onto dry plants until damp but not to dripping. Always treat new growth on established conifers. Re-apply as necessary if risk of feeding damage persists.

<u>All other outdoor ornamentals (e.g., trees, shrubs, flowers):</u> Apply before browsing begins (e.g., early spring). Spray plants until wet but not dripping. Always apply to new growth. Re-apply as necessary if browsing damage persists. Note: Treat pine before or after, but not during, bud-flush period.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

DO NOT ingest. Wash hands with soap and water after handling. For good hygiene practice, wear waterproof gloves when handling this product.

FIRST AID:

If on skin: Take off contaminated clothing, flush the skin with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for advice on treatment

.If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for

15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.
