#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

To be used only in the manufacture of insecticides which are registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*. This product is to be used with appropriate solvents and/or carriers and, in the case of pressurized products, propellents, to produce an insecticide product.

Do not use in food handling, storage or preparation areas while food is present.

Mix well in drum before sampling and each use.

If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
