DIRECTIONS FOR USE

C-6104 Adjuvant is a blend of oil surfactant designed for use with ODYSSEY Water-Dispersible Granular Herbicide, Reg. No. 25111 on field peas and imazethapyr tolerant canola (e.g. canola with the SMART® trait). Use at a rate of 0.5% v/v (5 L **C-6104** per 1000 L total spray solution). Refer to the herbicide label for detailed use instructions.

MIXING

- 1. Thoroughly clean the sprayer prior to use. For appropriate cleaning instructions, refer to the label of the product sprayed previously.
- 2. Fill spray tank half full with clean water.
- 3. Add the desired amount of ODYSSEY Water-Dispersible Granular Herbicide and **C-6104 Adjuvant** and continue filling.
- 4. After filling, continue agitation.
- 5. Immediately after use, thoroughly clean the sprayer by completely filling spray tank with clean water while adding 1 litre of ammonia (containing 3% ammonia) per 100 litres of water. Agitate to mix water and ammonia. Reduce amount of ammonia added proportionally if higher concentrations of ammonia are used. Flush solution through boom and nozzles, and then add more water to completely refill the tank. Agitate the solution for at least 15 minutes and then flush the boom and nozzles until the spray tank is empty.
- 6. Remove the nozzles and screens and clean separately in a bucket containing a cleaning agent and water.
- 7. Fill spray tank half full with clean water.
- 8. Agitate to thoroughly rinse the tank and flush the water through the boom.

PRECAUTIONS

- 1. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
- 2. Corrosive to skin. May cause eye irritation. DO NOT get on skin or in eyes.

FIRST AID INSTRUCTIONS

IN CASE OF EYE CONTACT: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
