DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

In-Container Preservation:

Since the level of contamination and the nature of the formulation can vary, we recommend testing formulations to confirm the effective level of Surcide P. Contact the manufacturer for assistance. The following should be used as a guide only:

Water-based products including adhesives*, resin solutions, printing inks, stuccos, joint compounds, floor finishes, and liquid polishes:

Add 0.05-0.3% Surcide P to the formulation by liquid pour or metering pump.

***Note:** Not for use in adhesives having either direct or indirect food contact.

Machine cleaner must be added by closed transfer system. DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

DANGER: CORROSIVE TO EYES

Wear eye protection when handling. Do not get in eyes. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid skin contact.

All mixers and other handlers must wear: long-sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes plus socks, chemical-resistant gloves, goggles or face shield.

Formaldehyde can be released during use of this product. Ensure that formaldehyde air concentrations in the workplace do not exceed the exposure levels established by the occupational health and safety authorities in your jurisdiction (e.g., engineering controls, monitoring). FIRST AID:

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and PCP Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
