DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

COOLING WATER SYSTEMS: For the control of algae, bacteria, and fungi in commercial and industrial cooling water systems, add AQUAGUARD 602 as follows:

Initial dose: 20 to 120 mL per 1000 L water in the system.

Maintenance dose: Every 1 to 5 days or as needed, 6.4 to 40 mL per 1000 L of water in the system.

DISPOSAL:

- 1) Triple or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
- 2) Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
- 3) Make the empty container unusable for further use.
- 4) Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
- 5) For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish and other aquatic organisms. It is not to be used in circumstances that would cause or allow it to enter lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters in contravention of federal or provincial regulatory requirements. PRECAUTIONS: DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. DANGER. POTENTIAL SKIN SENSITIZER. Corrosive, causes eye and skin damage. Harmful if swallowed. Wear a full-face NIOSH approved respirator, chemical resistant gloves, long pants, a long sleeved shirt, shoes plus socks and a chemical resistant apron and safety glasses or face shield during mixing/loading, clean-up and repair activities. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, clothing or the contamination of food. Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, and when using tobacco or the toilet. Users should remove clothing/protective equipment immediately if this product comes in contact with the skin through soaked clothing or spills. Then, thoroughly wash the skin and put on clean clothing. Discard

clothing or other absorbent materials that have been drenched or heavily contaminated with the concentrate of this product. Do not re-use them. Keep the container closed when not in use. Do not reuse the container. Destroy when empty. Do not apply by open pouring of the liquid to cooling water systems; a metering pump is required for this use.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed : Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give **any** liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing : Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled : Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes : Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
