DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide registered under the *PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT*.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND/OR PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Potential skin sensitizer. Avoid contact. Avoid breathing dust or fumes. Wash thoroughly after using or before eating or smoking. Wear protective clothing including goggles and respirator when handling technical material.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

When the technical has been ingested, carry out gastric lavage with care to prevent aspiration. Treatment of intoxication should be symptomatic and supportive.

STORAGE:

Keep in original container during storage. Do not contaminate or store near feed, seeds, or foodstuffs. Keep away from fire, open flame, or other sources of heat. Normal storage temperatures should be between 5-30 °C.

DISPOSAL AND DECONTAMINATION:

Canadian formulators of this technical should dispose of unwanted active and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations.
