DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hyamine 3500-50% is a concentrate for formulating purposes only.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHROIZED PERSONNEL. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls.

Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.
