PRECAUTIONS

Danger - Corrosive. DO NOT ingest, inhale, get in eyes or on skin. Contains crystalline silica, which can cause cancer. Risk of cancer depends on duration and level of exposure.

FIRST AID

DO NOT apply this product in a way that will contact workers or bystanders, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DO NOT apply this product directly to freshwater habitats (such as lakes, rivers, sloughs, ponds, prairie potholes, creeks, marshes, streams, reservoirs and wetlands), or estuarine/marine habitats.

For use on metal and fibreglass boat hulls to control the growth of fouling organisms. Controls common types of fouling for a period up to 3 years depending on sailing pattern, water temperature, and the system applied.

Before using, power agitate to a uniform consistency. Bare steel surfaces should be blasted before the application of the primer. Surfaces must be suitably prepared and primed before application of 5297HS Sigmaplane Ecol Antifouling Paint. Do not apply below 2°C (36°F) unless care is taken to ensure absence of frost or ice. Surfaces to be painted shall be free of dirt, oil, grease, and other surface contaminants. Product must be allowed to dry at least 8 hours before immersion. Large vessels over 25 metres must be treated by trained applicators.
