DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. Initial dosage for pool water having no visible algae is 135 mL of AQUARIUS LIQUID ALGAECIDE 15 per 10,000 L of pool water.
- Weekly maintenance dosage is 70 mL of AQUARIUS LIQUID ALGAECIDE 15 per 10,000 L of pool water.
- 3. For pool water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.
- 4. For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 335 mL of AQUARIUS LIQUID ALGAECIDE 15 per 10,000 L of pool water.

DO NOT apply when swimmers are in the immediate vicinity (a 15 minutes restricted-entry interval is recommended).

PRECAUTIONS:
