PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCES BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. May irritate the skin and eyes. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash hands and face after handling and before eating, using tobacco (including smoking), applying cosmetics or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

TOXIC to aquatic organisms. DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

FIRST AID

- If swallowed** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- If on skin or clothing** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

- If in eyes** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

STORAGE
