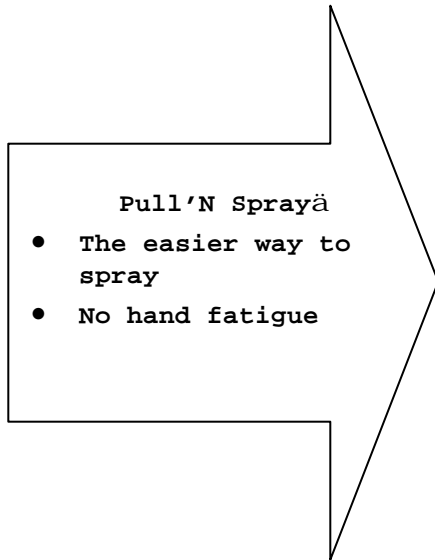

- Remove sprayer from side carrier and unwrap hose completely.
- Insert (colour) plug at end of hose into (colour) spout on cap until it clicks.
- Flip up spout.

*[ILLUSTRATION #2]*

- Point sprayer away from body.
- Grasp sprayer by the handle.
- Slowly pull ring at bottom of sprayer handle until it stops to ready the sprayer.

*[ILLUSTRATION #3]*

- Twist nozzle at end of sprayer to adjust spray pattern.]

*[ILLUSTRATION #4]*

- Press button on sprayer to begin spraying and hold down for continuous spray.
- Pull ring at sprayer bottom again as needed for additional spraying.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

**HOW TO APPLY**

Follow illustrations and instructions above.

- 1. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING - SPRAYS A FINE MIST OR JET STREAM**
2. Twist nozzle at end of sprayer to open.
3. Point sprayer away from body and press sprayer button to begin spraying.

4. Pull ring at base of sprayer as needed to continue spraying.
5. Adjust nozzle to provide desired spray pattern. Spray to provide thorough coverage of both upper and lower leaf surfaces.
6. Insects must be contacted by spray to be killed.
7. Repeat as needed.

**WHEN TO APPLY**

1. Spray in early morning or in the evening.

**IMPORTANT**

1. Use with caution on young plants and new growth.
2. Do not spray in direct sunlight.
3. Do not use on maiden hair ferns.
4. Use only on plants and pests listed below:

**CONTAINER USE AND STORAGE DIRECTIONS:** *[icon & illustration]*

Follow illustrations and instructions to ready the sprayer. Twist nozzle at end of sprayer to adjust spray pattern. Point sprayer at unwanted insects and press sprayer button to begin spraying. Hold down for continuous spray. Pull ring at sprayer bottom again as needed for additional spraying. Completely dispense product in sprayer prior to storage. Twist sprayer nozzle to the OFF position. Flip down (colour) spout on cap. NO NEED TO DISCONNECT SPRAYER HOSE FROM CAP. Place sprayer back inside carrier on bottle with the nozzle facing down. Store this product in its original container in a secure area away from children and pets. Protect container from freezing.

**PRECAUTIONS:**

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not allow others such as children and pets on treatment area during application or to re-enter treated areas until spray has dried. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after using. If used indoors, remove birds and pets from room being sprayed for one hour. This product is toxic to fish. Cover aquariums for one hour. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

**FIRST AID:**

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
