DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act.

PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse.

FIRST AID

If in eyes Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
