## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

To be used only in the manufacture (formulating, repackaging, repouring) of a pest control product solely for export from Canada.

## **PRECAUTIONS**

1. **PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.**
2. Harmful if swallowed.
3. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing.
4. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before re-use.
5. Avoid contamination of food, feed or water.

## **FIRST AID**

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Treat symptomatically.

### **If swallowed:**

Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If in eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take the container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

The patient should be treated symptomatically.

## **STORAGE**

1. Keep the leftover product in original container during storage.
2. Store product in cool, dry, well-ventilated place away from seed, fertilizer or other pesticides.
