### DIRECTION FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the *PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT*.

### PRECAUTIONS:

#### PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Strictly observe all precautions for handling and using pesticides. May irritate eyes. May irritate skin. Potential skin sensitizer. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wear protective goggles when handling. **DO NOT** wear contact lenses while handling. Use of an approved pesticide respirator is recommended. Wear coveralls or long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical resistant gloves, boots and goggles when handling. Wash gloves thoroughly with soap and water before removing them during, or following, any operation. Wash exposed areas of skin thoroughly with soap and water after handling product and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, smoking or using the toilet. **DO NOT** eat, drink or smoke during handling. Remove contaminated clothing **IMMEDIATELY** after use. Wash exposed areas of skin thoroughly with soap and water after handling contaminated clothing.

### FIRST AID:

**IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

There is no specific antidote. If this product is ingested, treat symptomatically.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:**

**TOXIC to aquatic organisms. DO NOT** discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

#### **STORAGE:**
