DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture (formulating, repackaging, repouring) of a pest control product solely for export from Canada.

DO NOT discharge effluents containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. CORROSIVE to the eye. DO NOT get in eyes. May be fatal if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust, mist or vapour. Avoid generating dust. Provide adequate ventilation. Harmful if swallowed. Potential skin sensitizer. Wear chemical resistant gloves and goggles or a face shield when handling the product.

FIRST AID:

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
