DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture or formulating of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Strictly observe all precautions for handling and using pesticides. May be harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not breathe dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

FIRST AID:

Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. **Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.**
- IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

STORAGE:
