DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Prescription Treatment Brand Avert Plus Canadian Carpenter Ant Bait

Prescription Treatment Brand Avert Plus Canadian Carpenter Ant Bait is a ready-to-use product for use in controlling ants both indoors and outdoors. This bait formulation combines a mixture of foods and the delayed action insecticide, abamectin. This insecticide acts to reduce the population of worker ants resulting in colony elimination. Avoid use of other insecticides or sprays on or near Prescription Treatment Brand Avert Plus Canadian Carpenter Ant Bait.

Only to be used by individuals holding an appropriate pesticide applicator certificate or license recognized by the provincial/territorial pesticide regulatory agency where application occurs.

FOR INDOOR USE: Follow ants back to voids. Apply product where ants are active, to cracks and crevices, voids or other areas that are inaccessible to children and pets. In heavily traveled sites use up to 42 g product. Use a large Centrobulb* puffer, duster or other appropriate application device to place the product into crevices or voids. Bait may be placed at same rate in appropriate child resistant bait stations that are secured in place. Place bait stations next to sites of ant activity or suspected ant activity areas. Repeat baiting when bait is consumed or no longer palatable. Bait must be placed in areas inaccessible to children and pets.

FOR OUTDOOR USE: Apply product in appropriate child resistant bait stations that are secured in place. Place bait stations next to sites of ant activity or suspected ant activity areas. Repeat baiting when bait is consumed or no longer palatable. Bait must be placed in areas inaccessible to children and pets.

Do not use in the food/feed areas of food/feed handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are defined as those areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Non-food areas are defined as areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS
