DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Fungitrol 420MC Fungicide is sold for industrial use only. Formulators are responsible® for their own registration. To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act.

USE LIMITATIONS: Not to be used in the manufacture of any wood, paper or paperboard that will come into contact with food.

PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Causes skin irritation and irreversible eye damage. Do not get on skin, or on clothing or in eyes. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing vapour or spray mist. Provide adequate ventilation. Wear goggles or a face shield, chemical-resistant gloves, socks and chemical resistant footwear during mixing, loading, application, clean-up and repair. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.
