PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Corrosive to eyes and skin. DO NOT get in eyes, or on skin or clothing. Potential skin sensitizer. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. May be fatal if inhaled. DO NOT breathe dust or sprays. Avoid generating dust. Provide adequate ventilation. Wear a full face respirator OR goggles and a half-mask respirator with a NIOSH/MSHA/BHSE approved organic-vapour-removing cartridge with a prefilter approved for pesticides OR a NIOSH/MSHA/BHSE approved canister approved for pesticides, a long-sleeved shirt and long pants and chemical resistant gloves during mixing, loading, application, clean-up and repair. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining personal protective equipment. If no such instructions exist for washables, use detergent and hot water. FIRST AID:

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

STORAGE:

Maintain tightly closed container. Store in a dry place.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For use as a preservative in manufacturing paints, plastics and adhesives. DO NOT use for plastic for toys.

For the following applications, Fungitrol 400SE Fungicide is to be added during mixing of the raw materials for ease of incorporation into the finished product.

Exterior Paint Dry Film: 0.1 – 0.2% by weight (1000-2000 ppm a.i.)

Plastics: (to protect against mildew and fungal growth on products exposed to humid conditions that are not subject to constant wetting such as rain (e.g. vinyl siding) or running water (e.g. PVC pipes)): 0.025 – 0.1% by weight (250 – 1000 ppm a.i.)

Adhesives: 0.02 – 0.05% by weight (200 – 500 ppm a.i.)

The optimum amount of Fungitrol 400SE Fungicide that is required for adequate preservation is best determined by actual tests with the specific material, within the registered range of rates.

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters

DISPOSAL:

1. Triple- or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
