### **PRECAUTIONS:**

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May irritate eyes. Avoid contact with eyes. Potential skin sensitizer. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Use only in well-ventilated areas. Do not wear contact lenses.

Workers must wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical resistant gloves and goggles or face shield during mixing, loading, clean-up and repair. When handling the concentrate, wear full face protection with cartridge respirator and chemical resistant gloves, apron, cap and boots.

Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining personal protective equipment. If no such instructions exist for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash personal protective equipment separately from other laundry. Users should remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove personal protective equipment immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible wash thoroughly.

Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

### **DISPOSAL/DECONTAMINATION**

1. Triple-or pressure rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the productions batch.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill or for clean-up of spills.

### **FIRST AID:**

**If in eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after 5 minutes, and then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

**If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or an ambulance then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

***DIRECTIONS FOR USE:***

**READ THE LABEL BEFORE USING.**

Use levels for Micropel A285. All rates are in percentage by weight and refer to the product Micropel A285. Rates of 0.6-1.7% Micropel A285 must be followed. In order to determine the most cost effective use level for Micropel A285 in within this range field trials are suggested. Micropel A285 is added to the manufacturing process in two ways: 1) to the compounding resin and extruded for use in the end use application or 2) added to the final formulation to produce an extruded and/or cured final article.

**MICROPEL A285 IS NOT TO BE USED IN MATERIALS THAT WILL BE IN CONTACT WITH FOOD OR DRINKING WATER.**

**Flexible PVC Film:** Micropel A285 should be added in the plasticizer part of the formulation and extended periods of exposure to temperatures of 171-204°C should be avoided.

DO NOT use for plastic for toys. DO NOT contaminate irrigation or dinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

This pest control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on the label.
