PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals. Caution. Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Avoid breathing vapours. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

FIRST AID

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor IMMEDIATELY for further treatment advice.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If Swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor IMMEDIATELY for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Note to Physician: Aim (Carfentrazone-ethyl) Technical Herbicide is expected to have low oral and dermal toxicity, and moderate inhalation toxicity. It is expected to be slightly irritating to the skin and minimally irritating to the eyes. Treatment is otherwise controlled removal from exposure followed by symptomatic and supportive care.

STORAGE: Keep in original container during storage. Store product in cool, dry, well-ventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer, or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame, or other sources of heat.

DISPOSAL: Canadian formulators using this product should dispose of unwanted active ingredient and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations.
