DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

DO NOT apply to surfaces that may come into contact with food/feed. Cover or remove all food/feed. Cover all food/feed processing surfaces, equipment and utensils or thoroughly wash following treatment. **DO NOT** administer by mouth. Shake bottle well before using. Wet dog or cat thoroughly with warm water. Apply shampoo and rub shampoo into coat beginning at the head and working backward until entire body is covered (approximately 5 mL/kg). Pay special attention to neck, hindquarters, areas under legs, around the tail and between toes. **DO NOT** apply to dog or cat's face, eyes, nose, mouth or genitals of **dog or cat**. Rinse the dog or cat thoroughly with water to remove all traces of shampoo. Avoid contact with dog or cat's mouth, face, eyes and genitals. For difficult infestations, allow the lather to remain for 3 – 5 minutes. Rinse thoroughly to remove all traces of shampoo on the dog or cat's coat. **DO NOT** use on dog or cats under 8 weeks of age. **DO NOT** treat nursing females. **DO NOT** use on sick animals. **DO NOT** use on animals under drug or pesticide treatment.. Treatment must be repeated only if the pest problem reoccurs.

Ticks are difficult to control, therefore take care to treat ticks individually. For effective flea and tick control, treatment of the **dog or cat** should be combined with sanitation of any area used by the dog or cat. Vacuum floors, carpets and furniture (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the dog or cat's bedding, living quarters and surrounding areas. If pest problems persist, a premise treatment with an insecticide labelled for that use may be required. A veterinarian should be consulted when flea infestation continues to be a problem on the dog or cat.

USE LIMITATIONS:

DO NOT allow dog or cat to lick the suds from the coat or to ingest any of the shampoo.

DO NOT use on puppies or kittens less than 8 weeks old. **DO NOT** use on dogs or puppies weighing less than 0.2268 kg. **DO NOT** use on cats or kittens weighing less than 1.5 kg.

DO NOT USE ON ANY OTHER ANIMAL

Consult a veterinarian before using on sick, aged, pregnant or nursing animals or animals receiving drug or other pesticide treatment.

DO NOT administer by mouth.

DO NOT use solely as a shampoo when there is no pest problem.

This product contains Pyrethrins and Piperonyl butoxide. **DO NOT** apply another pest control product such as a shampoo, spot on, collar or powder which contains Pyrethrin or Piperonyl butoxide to the treated animal when using FLEA AND TICK PET SHAMPOO FOR DOGS AND CATS.

DO NOT use this shampoo more often than once every 2 weeks.

PRECAUTIONS:

HUMANS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. May irritate eyes. Avoid contact with mouth, eyes, skin and clothing. Use ONLY in well-ventilated area, preferably outdoors. After handling or applying, wash hands (or any other skin that came into contact with the product) with soap and water. Avoid contact with treated animals until dried. **DO NOT** allow product to contact non-target surfaces. Avoid product contact with food, food utensils or places where food is prepared or stored.

PETS: Harmful if swallowed.. For information regarding medical emergencies or pesticide incidents, call 1-817-251-6300.

Side Effects:

Monitor your dog after application. Side effects may include: skin irritation such as redness or scratching; changes in behaviour such as agitation or lethargy; or gastrointestinal effects such as vomiting or loss of appetite. If these or other side effects occur consult your veterinarian or registrant at 1-817-251-6300.

Monitor your cat after application. Side effects may include: skin irritation such as scratching or hair loss at the application site, or changes in behaviour such as agitation or lethargy. Gastrointestinal effects such as drooling, vomiting, or loss of appetite may also occur. If these or other side effects occur consult your veterinarian or registrant at 1-817-251-6300.

FIRST AID:

HUMANS: IF SWALLOWED, **DO NOT** induce vomiting. Obtain medical attention or call a poison control centre immediately. IF ON SKIN, wash affected areas with soap and water. IF IN EYES, flush eyes with plenty of water. If

skin or eye irritation persists, obtain medical attention.

PETS: Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide for companion animals. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your dog or cat with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately. Take container, label, or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical or veterinary attention.
