DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To kill 99.9% of bacteria in 5 minutes on soft surfaces:

Clean soiled areas before using. From a distance of 15 to 20 cm, spray on fabrics until slightly damp. DO NOT SATURATE. Fabric must remain wet for 5 minutes. Allow surface to completely dry before reuse. On fabrics which may water spot (such as silk) test a small area of fabric that cannot be seen. Not recommended for use on leather or suede. For difficult odours or heavy fabrics, repeat application. For spot treatment (5 cm x 5 cm area) only.

FIRST AID TREATMENT:
