DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

PRECAUTIONS: PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORISED PERSONNEL. Harmful if swallowed. May irritate eyes. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash water or rinsate. When handling, wear safety glasses, and dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C).

STORAGE: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children, pets and domestic animals. Store apart from pesticides, fertilizers, food or feed that may cause cross-contamination from odour. Keep container closed when not in use.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.
If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told

to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: There is no specific antidote for this product. Treat symptomatically.
