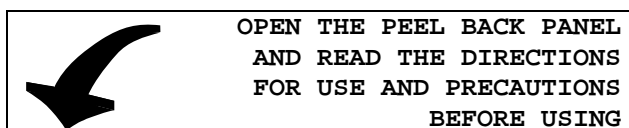

USE AND STORAGE DIRECTIONS FOR THE QUICK CONNECT™ SPRAYER:

1. Pull trigger sprayer from bottle.
2. Pull hose connector and coil from trigger sprayer handle.
3. Insert hose connector into spout on cap until it "clicks" in place.
4. Flip up spout.
5. Adjust spray nozzle to STREAM for cracks and crevices or FOAM, which marks treated weeds, allowing you to easily see where you've sprayed.
6. Aim sprayer nozzle at centre of weed and spray to wet.
7. Storage: After use, flip spout down to the "flat" position to close. No need to disconnect trigger sprayer. Close nozzle on trigger sprayer. Snap trigger sprayer back into place on bottle.

CONTROLS OVER 50 VARIETIES OF LAWN WEEDS

CONTROLS: Dandelion, Plantain, Chickweed, Clover, Bedstraw, Black Medick, English Daisy, Curled Dock, Heal-all, Ground Ivy (Creeping Charlie), Knotweed, Ragweed, Shepherd's-Purse, plus over 35 other broadleaf weeds.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

- This product is only effective when applied to the leaves of actively growing weeds. This product will not prevent new weeds - apply only when weeds are present.
- DO NOT water within 24 hours after application. Rain within 6 hours reduces effectiveness.
- Spray acts within a few days and weeds gradually die. Grass fills in as weeds disappear.
- Some weeds may require up to 4 weeks for complete kill. Repeat in 3-4 weeks if necessary.
- This product is designed to target treatment of weedy areas of lawns.
- DO NOT apply to any body of water.
- DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
- Desirable broadleaf terrestrial plants can be harmed by contact with product spray. DO NOT directly spray or allow the spray to drift onto ornamental plants and trees, fruits, vegetables or exposed roots of trees and ornamentals.
- This product may injure bentgrass.
- Avoid application of this product when winds are gusty.
- DO NOT apply to driveways, sidewalks or any other hard surface.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not store near seeds, fertilizers, insecticides or fungicides. Keep from freezing. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Store in original container in a dry, secured storage area. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

Protective Clothing:

- Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant gloves.

Operator Use Precautions:

- Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet.
- After treating, wash thoroughly.
- If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash contaminated skin thoroughly and shower. Launder contaminated clothing separately before reuse.

Re-entry Interval for Turf:

- Do not allow people (other than the applicator) or pets on the treatment area during application.
- Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

Maximum Application Frequency to Turf:

- For good turf/lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot treatments.

FIRST AID:
