##### PRECAUTIONS

###### PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

May cause sensitization. Causes eye and skin irritation. DO NOT get on skin and in eyes. Avoid contact with clothing.

Wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, waterproof gloves, eye goggles and dust/mist filtering respirator/mask (MSH/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C) or a NIOSH approved respirator/mask with any N-95, R-95, P-95 or HE filter when handling the product and during all clean-up/repair activities. If swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice.</li> <li>• Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.</li> <li>• Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor.</li> <li>• Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.</li> </ul>
If inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Move person to fresh air.</li> <li>• If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.</li> <li>• Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.</li> </ul>
