DIRECTION FOR USE: This product can be used to control damage caused by skunks, dogs, cats, rabbits, raccoons, beavers, mice, rats, deer, squirrels, voles, porcupines and some types of granivorous birds, fruit eating birds and carrion crows. Generously apply to dry surfaces. Do not apply on rainy or windy days. Spray on bark of trees, bushes, ornamental plants and flowers, bulbs, siding, fences, posts, garbage, and places visited by undesirable animals. Spray all surfaces to be protected until completely wet. Allow to dry before handling or re-applying. For additional protection, a second application may be necessary. Do not dilute! Do not mix with other chemicals! This product penetrates the bark of the trees and the outer layer of plants and flowers. The repellent remains intact and withstands outside elements. Annual re-application is advised. Before using on painted surfaces, test a small area to determine whether this product's ingredients will damage the paint. Do the same with plastics and fabrics. If in doubt, test first! Store this product in cold areas away from heat.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, food and clothing. Abstain from tasting. The taste is extremely bitter and really unpleasant. Never use on food, edible plants or directly on the fruit or nuts of trees. Do not use on sugar maple trees, if sap is to be used, since the product could affect the taste of the maple syrup. This product has not proven to be harmful to plants when used as directed, but as an added precaution a test should be made before applying. Do not smoke or eat while applying. Wash hands thoroughly after use. Wear chemical resistant gloves when handling product or contaminated equipment. Do not enter treated area until spray has dried. For outdoor use only.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number, with you when seeking medical attention.

APPLICATOR DIRECTIONS:

1. Remove	 Remove applicator from side clip. Unwrap hose completely. [Illustration #1] Remove protective strip from battery compartment to activate batteries. [Illustration #2]
2. Connect	Insert plug at end of hose into [spout/knob/opening] on cap <u>until it clicks</u> . [Flip up spout./Flip up spout until fully upright./Twist [spout/knob] to "ON"./Pull spout up.] [Spout must remain up while spraying.] [Illustration #3]
3. Extend	Flip open applicator wand until it locks into position. [Illustration #4]
4. Spray	Twist nozzle at end of applicator wand to desired spray pattern. Ensure trigger lock is disengaged before spraying. Hold trigger for continuous spray. Release trigger to stop spray. [Illustration #5]

<u>Important Use Information</u>: Do not submerge in water. When storing sprayer for long periods, remove batteries.

<u>To replace batteries</u>: Open battery compartment at bottom of applicator handle. Remove used batteries and replace with AA batteries in correct position as marked per diagram inside battery compartment. Securely close battery compartment door. Always use a complete set of the same type when replacing batteries. Never mix alkaline, carbon-zinc or rechargeable batteries.

STORAGE:

[Close spout on cap./Flip down spout on cap./Flip spout down to the "flat" position to close./Twist [spout/knob] to "OFF"./Push spout down.] NO NEED TO DISCONNECT SPRAYER HOSE FROM CAP. Completely discharge/dispense product in sprayer onto the treatment area prior to storage. Twist sprayer nozzle to the OFF position. Engage trigger lock. Flip the wand closed and place sprayer back inside clip.
