DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the **PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT**.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Strong oxidizing agent. Use only clean, dry utensils. Contamination with moisture, dirt, organic matter or other chemicals (including other pool chemicals) or other foreign matter may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. Avoid any contact with flaming or burning material, such as a lighted cigarette. Keep product dry in lightly closed container when not in use. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. May be fatal if inhaled. **DO NOT** breathe dust or vapours. Corrosive to eyes and severely irritating to skin. **DO NOT** get in eyes or on skin and clothing.

STORAGE:

Store container in a cool, dry location, well ventilated area away from fire, flame or other sources of heat.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 – 20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration; preferable by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and PEST Control Product Registration number with you when seeking medical attention.
