## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Preservation uses: Slurries used in papermaking processes. DOSAGES OF PREVENTOL OF 45 BASED ON WEIGHT OF THE FORMULATED SLURRY:

Calcium carbonate slurry: 0.03---0.045% (1.5-2.25 kg of product per 5,000 kg of slurry)  
Talcum slurry: 0.03---0.045% (1.5-2.25 kg of product per 5,000 kg of slurry)  
Titanium oxide slurry: 0.03---0.045% (1.5-2.25 kg of product per 5,000 kg of slurry)

To preserve calcium carbonate, talcum and titanium oxide slurries. Applied as fillers in the wet-end production of paper and paperboard including those that contact foods. Preventol OF 45 should be metered directly into the cooling step after the temperature falls below 50 degrees Celsius and homogenously distributed by stirring.

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

**PRECAUTIONS:** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. DANGER. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing vapour or mist. Do not take internally.

**PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT:** Applicators and other handlers must wear coveralls over long-sleeved shirt and long pants, chemical resistant gloves, socks and chemical resistant footwear during mixing, loading, application, clean up and repair. Wear protective eyewear and respiratory protection device.

## **FIRST AID:**

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call poison control centre or doctor IMMEDIATELY for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Treat symptomatically.

**STORAGE:** Keep in original container during storage. Store product in cool, dry, well-ventilated place away from seed, feed, fertilizer, or other pesticides. Keep away from fire or open flame, or other sources of heat.

**DISPOSAL:**

- 1. Triple-or pressure-rinse the empty container. Add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.*
- 2. Follow provincial instruction for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.*
