READY TO USE, SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

This insecticide may be used outdoors or in greenhouses throughout the growing season or as a pre-harvest treatment.

FIRST AID:

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment treatment advice.

TOXICOLOGY INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING:

This insecticide may be used outdoors or in greenhouses throughout the growing season or as a pre-harvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations.

To control insects named, apply this spray to provide thorough coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatments weekly or as needed to control infestations. May be applied one day before harvest. Do not spray in direct sunlight. Spraying in early morning or in the evening is preferred. Hit insects directly with spray. Use with caution on young plants and new growth. Spray when air is still and temperature is below 32°C.
