**HTH Spa Algae Kill** is an effective algaecide that can protect your spa or hot tub water. It can be used as a preventative treatment to keep algae from forming in your spa water. It can also treat visible algae that have already formed in your spa water.

### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Initial dosage for spa water having no visible algae is 20 ml of **HTH Spa Algae Kill** per 1000 L of spa water.

Weekly maintenance dosage is 7 ml of **HTH Spa Algae Kill** per 1000 L of spa water.

For spa water having visible algae, superchlorinate following label instructions of superchlorination product employed and wait for at least 24 hours before adding weekly maintenance dosage.

For visible algae, when superchlorination is not employed, add 25 ml of **HTH Spa Algae Kill** per 1000 L of spa water.

For proper sanitation, spa must be completely drained periodically. The number of days between complete spa drainage is equal to the volume of spa water in litres, divided by 10 times the maximum number of daily spa users. Refill spa with water and repeat "DIRECTIONS FOR USE".

Maximum spa water usage temperature is 40°C. Time spent in spa water at 40°C should not exceed 15 minutes.

**PRECAUTIONS:**

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not mix with any other chemical. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes.

**FIRST AID:**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 10-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:** Treat symptomatically.

**DISPOSAL:** Rinse container thoroughly before discarding. Offer container for recycling if available. Do not reuse empty container. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product, contact the manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency. Contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency in case of a spill, and for clean-up of spills.
