#### FIRST AID:

**Heat Exchangers, Cooling Towers, Condensers, Air Washers-** Pre-clean heavily fouled systems (eg with Chlorine). Shock dosages of EZ GUARD 2K7 LIQUID BIOCIDE at 100 ppm active ingredient based on water content of the system. Maintenance dosage 10-25 ppm.

**Pasteurizer Cooling Water Systems** – Avoid contamination of food in application of the product.
