DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

A level of 1.5% of this product based on total weight of plastic, will give excellent control against bacteria and mold organisms. This level is recommended for shower curtains, wall coverings and similar items. For certain vinyl items which may be subjected to extended outdoor weathering, a level of up to 2.5% of this product should be evaluated. Such items would include vinyl tarpaulins procured by military and naval agencies for protection of items subjected to extended outdoor storage.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN

Do not allow in direct contact with skin. Do not allow material to be splashed in eyes. Avoid contact with clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Do not reuse empty drums.

Arsenic can be released during the use of this product. It is recommended that this product must not be used in circumstances that would result in arsenic air concentrations in the workplace exceeding levels established by occupational health and safety authorities in your jurisdiction. FIRST AID INSTRUCTIONS:
