PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED

PERSONNEL. Fatal if swallowed. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. Potential skin sensitizer. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse. When handling this product, wear protective clothing; long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes and waterproof gloves.

ENVIRONMENTAL PRECAUTIONS:

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or physician immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 – 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or physician for treatment advice. IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and *Pest Control Product Registration Number* with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

No specific antidote is available. Treat the patient symptomatically.

STORAGE

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Store in a cool, dry place and in such a manner to prevent cross-contamination with other pesticides, fertilizers, food, and feed.
